## **MISS AQUAFEST SCHOLARSHIP PAGEANT 2010 OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Each delegate must be at least 4 years of age by January 1, 2010 and no older than 18.
2. Delegates must be single, female, never married, nor given birth to a child.
3. Delegates must be of good health and moral character.
4. All decisions as to eligibility shall be determined by the Miss Aquafest Scholarship Program.
5. All decisions of the judges are final and irrevocable.
6. Any delegate showing unsportsmanlike behavior will be disqualified. No refunds will be given.
7. Delegates hereby agree to release unconditionally and forever, any claim against Aquafest, Inc. The Miss Aquafest Scholarship Pageant, its officers, directors, volunteers, agents, subsidiaries, or agents, which they may have, by virtue of their participation in this pageant or any use of their name, likeness, voice and/or biography in connection with this pageant, including use in promotional and advertising material.
8. Aquafest, Inc. reserves the right to change the date and location of the local Pageant.
9. If for any reason a winner is disqualified, or elects not to participate, her title and all awards will be passed on to the next choice of the judges.
10. Board members of Aquafest, Inc. and members of their immediate families are eligible to participate in the competition. The exception is the immediate family of the pageant director, Aquafest President, Vice President, Second Vice President, Secretary or Treasurer. The immediate family of the aforementioned may compete and scored, but may not hold the division title. Instead, these members may compete for the title of Miss Aquafest Ambassadors ,

11. Delegates agree that if they win the division title they will not participate in any pageants during the time that they hold the title unless authorized in writing by the Miss Aquafest Scholarship Pageant which approval will not be unreasonably withheld.
12. Delegates and their parents/guardians agree to hold harmless all persons affiliated with Aquafest, Inc and the Miss Aquafest Scholarship Pageant in case of any loss or injury occurring during, or in travel to and/or from this program.
13. Recipients of the Aquafest titles promise to promote the program by making a minimum of 6 personal appearances during her reign, which would include a minimum of 3 parades including all Aquafest Week- end activities. Titleholders further promises to make no personal appearances or appear in any advertising and/or publications without permission from the Miss Aquafest Director and to return to the 2010 Miss Aquafest Scholarship Pageant to crown her successor.
14. Delegates agree that they accept their titles with the understanding that they choose to compete at the next level, they will assume all responsibility for payment of costs not awarded. Sponsorship fees are non-refundable.
15. Aquafest, Inc., and the Pageant Director reserves the right to combine or delete age divisions if less than 3 contestants per division. If age divisions are combined, delegates will still be scored according to their original age division rules.
16. Aquafest, Inc., and the Miss Aquafest Scholarship Pageant reserve the right to adjust awards and prizes based on the number of delegates that have entered. Title winners Princess through Jr. Teen will receive either a \$500.00 US Savings bond or its cash value (\$250). The Miss Aquafest Division will receive either a \$1000.00 US Savings bond or its cash value (\$500).
